Meetings on Proposed Zoning Regulations to Address Residential Compatibility

Fairfax County staff from the Department of Planning and Zoning and the Department of Public Works and Environmental Services will be seeking feedback from members of the building industry, the public, and other interested parties regarding proposed new zoning regulations designed to address building height and residential

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compatibility. Draft regulations are being developed to amend how building height is measured and to create a new setback ratio which will further restrict the height of homes in relation to their distance from the property line. The intent of the setback ratio is to limit the looming affect that can be created by tall structures built in close proximity to their property line.
